Meaning: (I meditate on Devi Jagaddhatri) Who exists as a Global Substratum, Incomprehensible; The One who is eternally contented, the One who endures all creation,

Eternal One, and take one straight to His eternal feet; Who Is Strong and Stable; O Devi Jagaddhtri, Greetings to You.

Meaning: (Meditating on Devi Jagaddhatri) Who stands in Figure of Corpse (a form similar to Shiva's corpse representing Brahman) in the form of Shakti (as Devi Kali representing Brahman's Power); Dwelling as Shakti within the Vigraha (Image) of Shakti (awakened by Worship),

Worshiper-Shaktas Traditions; O Devi Jagaddhatri, Greetings to You.

He Who Is All Kinds and Knows All (as a person within them); O Devi Jagaddhatri, Greetings to You.

Who is the essence after the manifestation of Creation, who exists as the Old Covenant of the Lord; O Devi Jagaddhatri, Greetings to You.

Playing in Creation by taking Infinite Forms, and staying in those Forms as Awareness; O Devi Jagaddhatri, Greetings to You.
